As forecasts point toward an especially cold winter across Alberta, Dandy Auto/Marine/RV Ltd. is reminding area drivers to schedule tire service and vehicle inspections before harsh conditions arrive. The Airdrie-based automotive and marine facility has issued the seasonal reminder alongside the launch of a new resource page dedicated to Airdrie preventive maintenance, aimed at helping motorists prepare their vehicles for the months ahead.

The timing of the reminder reflects the safety risks that accompany Alberta winters, where sudden temperature drops and icy roads place added strain on tires, batteries, and braking systems. Dandy notes that many mechanical failures during winter can be traced to maintenance tasks that were postponed until conditions had already deteriorated. The company encourages drivers to arrange Airdrie tire service early, before demand peaks with the first significant snowfall.

Airdrie vehicle inspections, including automotive pre-purchase inspections, out-of-province inspections, and multi-point vehicle checks. Each inspection type is designed to identify developing issues before they become costly repairs or roadside emergencies.

"Cold weather has a way of exposing small problems that drivers may not notice during warmer months," said Daryn Fyfe, Owner and Founder of Dandy Auto/Marine/RV Ltd. "The purpose of this reminder is straightforward. When tires are inspected and vehicles are checked ahead of winter, mechanical issues can be caught before they become serious problems on the road."

The new preventive maintenance page outlines the seasonal steps drivers can take to keep vehicles reliable through the winter, with particular attention to winter tire changes. Alberta regulations and safe driving practices make properly rated tires a central concern once temperatures fall, and the company advises against delaying the switch to winter tires. Scheduling early allows appointments to be arranged before service centres reach capacity.

Fyfe added that the company's approach centres on transparency and preparation. "The goal is to help drivers understand the condition of their vehicles before winter arrives, not after," he said. "A short inspection now can prevent a breakdown in freezing temperatures later."

The reminder forms part of the company's broader focus on preventive care. The facility promotes what it calls the Dandy Difference, a commitment to a clean and organized shop, certified workmanship, and clear communication with customers. The company maintains a combined technician experience exceeding 100 years.
