



## **Evergreen Landscape Pros Expands Landscaping Services to White Rock**

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Evergreen Landscape Pros has extended its full-service landscaping operations into White Rock, New Mexico, giving property owners in the Los Alamos County community direct access to a design, installation, and maintenance provider previously concentrated in the Santa Fe region. The expansion took effect this quarter and covers residential and light commercial properties throughout the White Rock area.

The move follows a period of steady demand from homeowners in northern New Mexico who have contacted the company for xeriscaping, native plant installation, irrigation upgrades, and hardscape construction. White Rock, situated on the Pajarito Plateau at roughly 6,400 feet in elevation, presents landscaping conditions distinct from those in lower-lying parts of the region, including volcanic tuff soils, high solar exposure, strong seasonal winds, and a shorter growing season. Evergreen Landscape Pros has assembled crews trained specifically for those conditions before opening service to the new territory.

Services now available to White Rock properties include landscape design and installation, sod and turf work, drip and sprinkler irrigation systems, retaining walls, flagstone and paver patios, outdoor lighting, seasonal cleanups, tree and shrub pruning, and ongoing lawn maintenance. Xeriscaping remains a central offering

because of persistent drought conditions across the state and Los Alamos County water-use guidelines that reward efficient outdoor water management. The company also builds fire-resilient landscape buffers, a service that has drawn attention in communities near the Jemez Mountains following the Cerro Grande and Las Conchas fire events of prior decades.

Kevin Lopez, Owner of Evergreen Landscape Pros, said the decision to enter White Rock reflected both customer requests and a review of service gaps in the surrounding market. "White Rock homeowners have needed a dedicated landscaping partner who understands high-desert conditions and fire-wise design, and this expansion closes that gap," said Lopez. He added that the company has hired additional field staff and added equipment capacity to support the new coverage without diluting service in existing territories.

According to the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer, outdoor irrigation can account for a substantial share of residential water use during summer months, and Los Alamos County has for several years encouraged the replacement of high-water turf with regionally adapted plantings. Evergreen Landscape Pros reports that more than sixty percent of recent design consultations across northern New Mexico have included some element of water-efficient landscaping, whether full xeriscape conversions, partial turf reduction, or upgrades from spray to drip irrigation. The company expects that ratio to hold or increase among White Rock projects.

The White Rock service area covers neighborhoods along State Road 4, including properties near Overlook Park, Piñon Park, and the residential streets extending toward the Bandelier National Monument boundary. Crews will dispatch from the company's existing northern New Mexico operations, with routing adjusted to keep response times for estimates and scheduled maintenance visits within the same windows offered to longer-standing service areas. Estimates remain free, and scheduling is handled through the company's existing intake process.

Founded to serve the Santa Fe metropolitan area, Evergreen Landscape Pros has gradually broadened its footprint across surrounding communities as staffing and equipment allowed. The addition of White Rock follows earlier extensions into nearby areas and represents the company's first formal presence in Los Alamos County. Lopez noted that the company reviewed licensing, insurance, and local ordinance requirements ahead of the launch to ensure full compliance with Los Alamos County code and New Mexico contractor regulations.

Industry data from the National Association of Landscape Professionals indicates that demand for drought-tolerant design and outdoor living construction has grown across the Southwest over the past five years, driven by climate patterns, wildfire concerns, and shifts in how homeowners use exterior space. Evergreen Landscape Pros plans to track project mix in White Rock through the first full season and adjust crew assignments based on the categories of work requested most often. Seasonal cleanups and irrigation

checks are expected to lead early bookings, followed by design-build projects scheduled for spring.
